Ladies and Gentlemen,

CAFA will give a partial scholarship of \$1,000.00 for a student to attend the 5 week French immersion class this summer at St. Ann University in Church Point, Nova Scotia, Ca. The 5 week summer session begins in July.

Each family (Thibodeaux, Boudreaux, Landry, Broussard etc.) who are members of CAFA can submit one name to CAFA.

The student, if 18 and older or the parents of the student if under 18 must be a paid member of your family organization. The student must be at least 15.

The student must commit to attend and complete the 5 week class, pay the difference in tuition, transportation to and from St. Ann and other incidental expenses. Failure to complete the 5 week session will mean forfeiture of the scholarship and the money will have to be returned to CAFA.

Once all names are submitted to CAFA, the CAFA officers will draw 1 name out of a hat and that person will be awarded the scholarship.

The deadline to submit your name to CAFA is March 1st, 2010. The name of the student must be submitted and signed by your family organization President and submitted to Ray Trahan, CAFA President, at 230 Gumbo Rd. Lafayette, La. 70508. You may want to call after a few days to make sure it was received. Any names received after the 1st of March 2010 will not be considered.
